TERMS OF REFERENCE

PURPOSE:

To provide a forum for the development, revision, approval and implementation of the policies, procedures, protocols, quidelines and standards used in the Manitoba Renal Program, in order to ensure:

- 1. Provision of quality patient care in a safe and cost effective manner.
- 2. Standardization of patient care.

Adherence to practice standards as outlined by College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (CRNM), College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Manitoba (CLPNM), Manitoba Regulated Professionals: Professional Associations Regulatory Bodies Resources, Canadian Nurses' Association (CNA), Canadian Association of Nephrology Nurses and Technicians (CANNT), Canadian Society of Nephrology (CSN) and Kidney Disease Improving Global Outcomes (KDIGO), National Kidney Foundation (NKF) Kidney Disease Outcomes Quality Initiative (KDOQI) Guidelines.

OBJECTIVE:

- 1. To collaborate in the development, revision, approval and implementation of policies, procedures, protocols, guidelines and standards which provide direction on the scope, function and responsibility for patient care.
- 2. To communicate with and to seek approval for provincial Manitoba Renal Program (MRP) policies, procedures, protocols, guidelines and standards within Brandon Regional Health Centre (BRHC); Health Sciences Centre (HSC) including Manitoba Local Renal Health Centers (MLRHC); St. Boniface Hospital (SBH); and Seven Oaks Hospital (SOH).
- 3. To liaise with all members of the multidisciplinary team.
- 4. To review nursing policies, procedures, protocols, guidelines and standards at least every three years and revise as required.

PROCESS:

- Terms of Reference will be reviewed every two years by the Membership of the MRP Policy and Procedure Committee members.
- 2. Terms of Reference and minutes will be made available to all personnel employed in renal care within the province of Manitoba.
- 3. Agenda and Minutes will be distributed to designated members.
- 4. The development or alteration of policies, procedures, protocols, guidelines and standards, will be made by the designated members by consensus and according to evidence-based research, documentation, literature, manufacturers' recommendations, standards, safety and cost effectiveness. These documents are forwarded to the Manitoba Renal Program Professional Advisory Committee for approval.
- 5. Designated members will communicate the activities of the committee to their respective areas.
- 6. Designated members are responsible for attending meetings and providing meaningful input.
- 7. Designated members are responsible for supporting and promoting revised policies, procedures, protocols, guidelines and standards of care to their colleagues.
- 8. All written comments received will be considered at the table.
- 9. Meetings may occur by conference call.
